- Limit the number of times per year that the premises be rented short term

The library is reaching out to people with borrowed books and requires a new return box for books that was borrowed by public works that will be returning the box. More volunteers are interested in helping out at the library.

- Plaque for Michael Vayda refurbished bench dedication at the "Memorial Park" at Kings Highway and Village Rd came in today and will be installed this week.

- Painting and repair of benches has been completed along Beach Ave. Benches at Village will be repaired and painted this week when plaque is installed.
- Replaced Danni Dedication bench at Anchor Beach as cement was cracked when
 it was dedicated and had deteriorated. All other benches would not be replaced in
 this manner as all were in good condition when dedicated.
- The two benches on New Haven Av. by Oyster River are in bad shape and should be replaced or removed. Directed to have Jim Mallico evaluate them and remove or we will repair.
- Warden requested Anderson AV sign be cleaned.
- Warden also requested the Dixon ST end of road be straightened or replaced. Jim Mallico will evaluate and implement.
