AN ACT CONCERNING SALARIES OF CITY OFFICIALS IN WILLIMANTIC.

Section 1. Section 1 of number 337 of the special acts of 1951 is amended to read as follows: The salaries of the several officials of said city, except the city clerk and treasurer, shall be paid quarterly. The mayor shall receive a salary of three thousand five hundred dollars per annum; each alderman-at-large shall receive a salary of one thousand dollars per annum; each alderman shall receive a salary of seven hundred and fifty dollars per annum; the city clerk and the treasurer shall receive annual salaries to be fixed by the common council before the year for which the salary is to be paid, and payable at such times as the common council may by ordinance determine. The city sheriff shall receive the legal fees provided by law for sheriffs.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect December 2, 1957.

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE ASSOCIATION STATUS OF WOODMONT TO BOROUGH STATUS.

Wherever used in number 431 of the special acts of 1903, as amended by number 363 of the special acts of 1907 and number 139 of the special acts of 1937, or any other special act referring to the Woodmont Association, the term "Woodmont Association" is amended to read "borough of Woodmont," and the word "association," meaning the Woodmont Association, is amended to read "borough."
